For the past 24 years, Dr. Fletcher has owned a private practice in Willis and Conroe Texas. Focused on cutting edge treatment, Dr. Fletcher has integrated TMJ functional treatment, implants, sinus lift procedures, Perio-Protect Method, as well as the use of L-prf to aid in healing. Dr. Fletcher is always looking to enhance a procedure or process to make it more repeatable and easier on both the patient and practitioner.
